

Migrant Farmworker's Clinic



The Migrant Farmworker clinic is held every Thursday from 2:00 pm until about 6:00 pm. We work out of the Centro de Los Pobres, a community center affiliated with a church in Avondale, CO. This is in the middle of farm country, where most of the workers are located.

The Center is open to anyone in need of free clothing, food, medical services and social work services. It is run by “Sister Nancy”, a nun and retired nurse. Most of the patients are Spanish Speaking and with very limited resources. We are often able to provide free medications (donated) and treat most walk-in issues. It functions as a “continuity clinic” since many of the pts use it as their primary care clinic.
