Trips to Haiti

SCFM and St. Mary Corwin Hospital are part of a Haiti initiative to build clinics and train medical personnel. Dr. James Smith (a local surgeon) leads a group at least once a year to do medical work for a week at a time at a clinic project in Haiti. Residents participate on a regular basis with these trips. Month Long Rotations Abroad:

Away rotation time in the second or third year can be used to organize a rotation abroad. The resident is required to find a certified preceptor for the rotation. It can be done in Family Practice as well as other specialties. It can sometimes be combined with language programs – as long as there is adequate clinical work to justify credit for the residency. We have had residents go to Mexico, Costa Rica, Africa, France, Dominican Republic and other countries. Some of the faculty have contacts already in certain countries.
